I am looking forward to a great year! This letter will explain some of the guidelines and expectations that I have for 7th grade math.

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The 7th grade math curriculum is very rigorous. We will be using the textbook "Go Math". It is a combined textbook/workbook. For each unit, students will tear out the section we are working on and put it in to a 3-prong folder. They should have this with them everyday (and bring it home at night). In addition to notes taken in class, each student should have many examples to complete assignments and homework. Homework should always be attempted. Incomplete homework sheets with no work will not receive credit. **HOMEWORK WILL BE WORTH 5 POINTS.**

Students will also have classwork grades. Since this is guided practice completed in class, it will usually receive a higher point value (**up to 20 points**).

Quizzes will be given periodically to check for understanding prior to a test. **Quizzes will be worth no more than 50 points.**

Tests will be given at the end of a unit. **Tests will be worth 100 points.** Students are able to retake tests, however they should fill out a test review sheet beforehand. Test review sheets have the student evaluate their mistakes prior to the test retake.

We will have math projects which range from **50—100 points**. Projects will cover math units that we have completed. These will be completed in class.

Special points of interest:

- STUDENTS CAN ONLY USE PENCIL TO COMPLETE MATH WORK. Math papers completed in pen/highlighter/marker will not be accepted.
- After school tutoring will be held on Wednesdays from 3:30-4:30. This will begin in September.
